Parking for Concert and afternoon rehearsal

Parking will be available in the University Car Park on the day of the concert—both for the afternoon rehearsal and the Concert itself. Vehicle access is from Lady Lane. There is a gate for pedestrians onto the High St directly opposite the Church.

Access for People with Disabilities

Whilst Coats Church does not have the easiest access for anyone with mobility difficulties, there is an easier access point at the rear of the Church on the east side. This can be accessed by car, in order to drop off passengers, and access to the Church is then by only a few steps; a ramp is available if necessary. Access to the Church is then on the level. Concert Dress

TCM had had the same concert dress since 1980 and (at the age of 30!) it was felt that we should try something different! After considering all kinds of things, the committee decided to change to all black with a **small** splash of red. This was well received last year and, as a result, the committee agreed that we should continue with this. This means:

Ladies- long black skirt or smart black trousers with a black top with either full length or $\frac{3}{4}$ length sleeves (i.e. no short sleeves); the small splash of red should be some kind of plain red accessory such as a scarf, jewellery etc.

Men- black or dark trousers with a black collared shirt; the splash of red for them will be a plain red tie (no patterns) and this can be a bow tie if preferred.

Choir Photograph

As most of you know, we had photographs taken of the choir during and after our concert in 2009 and have used these in publicity and on our website. However, as we have changed our concert dress since then, the committee feels it is important to update this with our current "look". We have therefore arranged to have a new photograph taken and this will be done as soon as possible after the concert.

We will confirm the exact arrangements to you but would ask that everyone will stay on after the concert for the photograph so we can make this as complete as possible. We anticipate that the arrangements will be the same as before and that the choir should leave the stage in the usual way after the concert and then come back upstairs once the photographer has been able to set up, orchestra chairs cleared away etc.


